FROM THE DESK OF REV NIHAL FERNANDO

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

As we enter the season of Advent, a time of anticipation and preparation, it is important for us to reflect on the profound meaning of this sacred period. Advent is more than just a countdown to Christmas; it is a time for us to prepare our hearts and minds to receive the greatest gift ever given—the birth of our Saviour, Jesus Christ.

The word Advent comes from the Latin adventus, meaning "coming" or "arrival."" Let us also share this love with others, especially those in need, so that the joy of Christ's birth may be known and felt by all.

May this Advent season be a time of renewal, hope and transformation for each of us. Together, let us welcome the birth of Christ with open hearts, rejoicing in the gift of Emmanuel—God with us.
