FROM THE DESK OF REV NIHAL FERNANDO

Dearly beloved in Christ, "Blessed are the peacemakers, for they shall be called children of God." — Matthew 5:9

In a world torn apart by conflict, division and hatred, the call to be instruments of peace has never been more urgent. We may pride ourselves on being part of a "civilized" society, yet our actions often betray a thirst not for peace but for power, control and even war. True civilization is not measured by technology or progress, but by the love, justice and reconciliation we embody in our daily lives.

Jesus Christ, the Prince of Peace, has shown us the way: "Peace I leave with you; my peace I give you. I do not give to you as the world gives" (John 14: 27). His peace is not superficial—it is deep, healing and transformative. It starts within our hearts and extends outward into our homes, our communities, our nation and the entire world.

The Apostle Paul reminds us, "If it is possible, as far as it depends on you, live at peace with everyone" (Romans 12: 18). Peace is not passive—it is active, it demands courage, sacrifice and humility. It means forgiving those who have hurt us, speaking up against injustice, and refusing to let bitterness take root in our hearts.

As Christians, we are not called to be mere observers but ambassadors of Christ, bringing reconciliation where there is division. In a time when war rages in many corners of the world and hatred threatens to overwhelm love, let us commit ourselves anew to the Gospel path of peace.

Let us begin with ourselves: let there be peace in our hearts. Let it overflow into our families and homes. Let our nation be healed of its wounds. And let the world know that the followers of Christ stand not for violence, but for the sacred dignity of every human life.

Let us work for peace, justice, and reconciliation—not tomorrow, but today. May the Lord bless us with His peace and make us instruments of it.
